Bronek Korda is one of BBC Scotland's best known and most widely respected creative talents. He joined the BBC in 1979 and has been a staff dubbing mixer since 1984, since then he has picked up numerous credits across the full breadth of TV genres. As a drama mixer he created the sound design for several BBC and Channel 4 series, ranging from the 1987 hit comedy drama Tutti Frutti, starring Robbie Coltrane and Emma Thompson, to BBC Scotland's long-running soap River City. Bronek continues to be highly in demand from internal and external productions and as a mentor and adviser to his colleagues in dubbing and across post production.
